I am beyond excited to welcome your child to the Music Program and our Band. Learning how to play an instrument is a great avenue for students to experience new forms of creativity and expression.

Our Schedule:

- Band meets every other day on Days 2, 4, and 6.
- 6th Grade meets during Period 5. 7th Grade meets during Period 6.
- Students have an instrument lesson once per cycle, grouped by instrument. (i.e., House A flutes)
- Students are only allowed to change music classes at the mid-year and end-of-year points.

Class Expectations:

- Students need their instrument and music for *every* class. Instruments can be stored in the hallway group space.
- Students should be respectful of their own and their peers' learning.
- Don't get discouraged!
 Playing an instrument can be tricky at times.
- Students are encouraged to play at home twice a week to reinforce concepts learned in class, even if only for 10 minutes!
